Laws of Game

International FutNet laws of game issued by UNIF Founding Meeting in Géneve 2010.

Competition Format

Matches between the men's national teams of the Czech Republic, France, Slovakia and Switzerland. Each match consists of three submatches – single, double and triple.

One-off accompanying event is the UNIF Founding Cup of women's and juniors national teams of the Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Slovakia and Switzerland.

Friday, 3 December 2010 - group matches in all categories (men, women, juniors)

Saturday, 4 December 2010 - final and third place matches in all categories

Venue

The sports hall in Nymburk (home venue of the basketball champions ČEZ Basketball Nymburk) has undergone extensive refurbishment of the stands and flooring and features a brand new game clock. The seating capacity is about 1400 plus 60 VIP floor seats.

Criteria for qualifying further

If two (2) or more teams win the same number of game points in group, the following criteria are in force:

- a) more game points from mutual matches
- b) higher difference in sets from mutual matches
- c) higher difference in set points from mutual matches
- d) same criteria in the same order a), b), c) from all games in the group
- e) drawing lots, if all the criteria are the same.
